



Invitation to Apply for Eligibility and to Bid

SECURITY SERVICES-AREA III

This is to formally invite your company in the bidding for the procurement of our company's Security Services-Area III.

Duty Free Philippines, a sector of the Philippine Tourism Authority through the **Corporate Budget of Duty Free Philippines 2006** intends to apply the sum of Eight Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand One Hundred Seventy Pesos (**PhP8,930,170.00**) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **Security Services-Area III (NAIA-I/CEBU MACTAN/CEBU LAHUG)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid opening.

The contract duration shall be for a period of six (6) months. The effective date of Contract shall be indicated in the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act," and is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to Republic Act 5183 (R.A 5183) and subject to Commonwealth Act 138 (C.A. 138). Only Bids from Bidders who pass the eligibility check will be opened. The bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall advance to the post-qualification stage in order to finally determine responsiveness of the bid to technical and financial requirements of the project. The contract shall then be awarded to the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder (LCRB) who was determined as such during the post-qualification procedure.

Bidders may obtain further information from **Duty Free Philippines** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **9:00AM-5:00PM, Mondays thru Fridays**.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by the Bidders from **November 23 to December 08, 2006** at the address stated below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00)**. The method of payment will be **Cash**. The Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his authorized representative.

Duty Free Philippines will hold a Pre-Bid Conference open to all parties on **November 28 at 10:00AM** at the address given below.

Bids and Eligibility Documents must be submitted at the address stated below on **December 11, 2006 at 2:00pm**. Eligibility check and opening of bids shall be at of the same date/venue. Late bids shall not be accepted. Bids shall be opened in the presence of the bidder or bidder's representative. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the form of Cash, Certified/Manager's/Cashier's Check, Bank Draft or Irrevocable Letter of Credit (1% of ABC) in the amount of **Eighty Nine Thousand Three Hundred One & 70/100 (PhP89,301.70)** or Bank Guarantee (1.5% of ABC) in the amount of **One Hundred Thirty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Two Pesos & 55/100 (PhP133,952.55)**.

Duty Free Philippines reserves the right to waive any formality on the eligibility requirements of this project. Furthermore, DFP reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, or declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract, and makes no assurance that a contract shall be entered as a result of this invitation without thereby incurring liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

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
