### **ENVIRONMENTALLY- FRIENDLY VALUE CHAIN**

#### **Policy Statement**

Duty Free Philippines Corporation (DFPC) recognizes the importance of sustainable development ensuring that the protection of the environment is highly regarded in the conduct of its business. DFPC is committed to safeguard and conserve the environment and its natural resources and to comply with all applicable environmental policies and regulations established by the National Government.

#### **Activities**

In compliance with “Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000”, DFPC have instituted the Waste Segregation System in 2001 and reduce its waste by actively promoting reuse or recycle activities to its employees in 2011 and providing reusable shopping bag (eco-bag) to its customer in 2012. DFPC established the proper disposal of the used generator oil and busted compact fluorescent lamp (CFL) in accordance with "Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Control Act of 1990". With the “Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999”, DFPC employed a Pollution Control Officer and regularly submits quarterly report to DENR in order to operate its generator. For its customer service “Hatid sa Gate” program, DFPC decided to procure an Electronic Jeepney in 2014 in its effort to help reduce fuel emission.

Beginning 2008, DFPC have been using energy efficient lights and air conditioning unit (ACU) and replaced its old ACU with new ones that uses the prescribed ozone friendly 134A refrigerant. DFPC motivated its employees to conserve energy by sharing part of the savings to them.
